Course Description — *Now all these things happened unto them for examples: and they are written for our admonition... I Corinthians 10:11.* This course is an introduction to the history of Christianity and the church starting at the close of the New Testament period and continuing to the twentieth century. Students will gain a historical basis for current church ministry by examining major historical events, key people, and theological developments within the church during this time span.

Course Prerequisite(s) – Prior to the first class, students should read the entire of the book of Acts in their *preferred translation* not a “Paraphrase”.

Course Objectives – As a result of this course the student will gain the following:

1. To provide students with a general survey of significant individuals and events that shaped the direction of church history
2. To understand the contribution church history has on providing perspective on the interpretation of scripture
