We were able to buy a super bike for Oliver and purchase 2 much needed hearing aids in which he uses everyday. It brought us great joy to also provide batteries for those hearing aids until the end of the year. We are so happy to be able to bless him like this. He is functioning normally now as he is studying on the computer. I will say, however, he enjoyed the (bike) the most because his previous one wasn't useful for him anymore. You can tell from the picture that he was so happy!





By now you are familiar with Szymon. He is a boy who is at risk due to congenital diseases. We haven't been able to communicate too much with him recently, but I am happy to say that we were able to provide an oxygen condenser so that he would be able to have oxygen therapy. Oxygen therapy is important to his health and recovery, with your help we were able to provide that for him.

In this letter, you will also see a picture of Konrad, a boy who has breathed through a respirator almost since birth. He is in complete isolation right now by his grandmother who is a nurse that takes care of him. Unfortunately we cannot visit him, but we were able to satisfy some of the physical needs that he required. We were able to provide him with a new seat for a bath lift. This was necessary for him due to the fact that he has outgrown the previous one, and also because he was in danger of damaging his bones. Thanks to your generosity, he no longer needs to worry about these problems.



In addition to these children, we have also provided assistance in other needs that have come up in the previous months of dealing with the pandemic. We provided assistance for others for remote home teaching, helped with a few other related shortcomings of some of the children, and we have been able to organize classes.

All of our kids and families are doing well and life is going on and changing rapidly. I will be write soon with new updates and news of how things are going here.
