Vision Sunday - Pastor Curt

This week, Pastor Curt talked about what God is doing at Victory and reminded us of the church's vision, which helps us follow God's plan for our lives and reach our full, God-given potential. The strategy for Victory Church is to take people on a journey to Know God, Find Freedom, Discover Purpose, and Make a Difference.

As we go through these first three strategic steps, we become equipped to accomplish the fourth, which is to Make a Difference. So many are making a difference here at Victory Church every week by playing a part on the Serve Team. Our church believes these four strategies are the keys to God's plan for our lives and the fulfillment of our mission. Let's commit to taking our next steps so that we can experience the true fulfillment God has in mind for us.

Discussion Questions
