

# WHEN PIGS FLY



## Big Idea

Pastor Brett – Part 2

We continued our series called When Pigs Fly and looked at Jesus' first miracle. In John 2, we learn a lesson from Jesus' mother Mary. In a request she had of Jesus, she told the servants to do whatever He says. Sometimes, God can ask something of us that is seemingly mundane or ordinary. As Jesus' followers, we are encouraged to be obedient and faithful in the seemingly mundane tasks of life for out of that obedience we can experience the miraculous power of Jesus. You can impact eternity by doing what you may think is insignificant like changing a baby's diaper, teaching, encouraging, helping, serving, leading, listening etc.

If we want to see the miraculous works of God then we need to 1) Accept the invitation to follow Jesus and allow Him to lead our life. 2) Ask Jesus for help when the "uh-oh" and "oops" of life happen to us and around us. 3) Be faithful to do what Jesus wants us to do.

What does Jesus want us to do? This message explains how we can know what God wants us to do; think of it as GPS = God's Position System. When we are faithful to do our part, however mundane and insignificant it seems, miracles can and do happen, Jesus manifests His glory, and people believe.

## Discussion Questions

- What miracle do you need God to perform in your life? Are you waiting on God for a miracle?
- From John 2:5-11, Discuss what are the servants asked to do. Jesus could have miraculously filled the 6 large jars with wine Himself, but He gave the servants a role to play and a behind the scene look at what was happening. That ~150 gallons weighed ~1,200 pounds! What jobs or roles are you a part of?
- Has He asked something of you that seems so ordinary that it feels unusual?
- What has been the result of you submitting to what He is asking?
- Can you recall a time when God did a miracle in what seemed like an impossible situation?
- What is Jesus asking you to do? What is your next step? It may seem mundane or insignificant to us but not to Jesus or to the ones who will experience His miracle!

## Prayer Focus

Father, thank You for being a God of miracles. Help me to believe that no matter what my situation may be, You are willing and able to do a miracle in my life. During these days of uncertainty, I pray that You will be near to me, protect me, and heal our land. Amen.

## Next Steps

This week, spend time asking God to reveal a need in your life that you haven't brought to Him yet. Surrender that need to God, and ask Him to do a miracle in your situation.

## Leader Tip

Be ready to share any miracle, big or small, that God has done in your life. Opening up about a miracle you've experienced may help them identify ways that God has moved in their lives as well.
