## Big Idea: Dream Again

Pastor Curt

This week Pastor Curt encouraged us to dream again! Even as this world and our country continue in chaos, God wants to show us how to live and dream in this season. Live your life excited for the things of God.

**Hebrews 11:1** - Faith is the substance of **things hoped for**,  
the evidence of **things not seen**. (NKJV)

Faith is the foundation of hopes and dreams. Some of you may say, 'you want me to dream?' 'I'm just trying to pay the electric bill'... 'I'm too old'... 'I'm just trying to make it through today.' BUT, Hope and Dreams are what faith is! PC talked about the 5 types of people that are in the room: Those with,

- 1) **No** dream (Jeremiah 33:3)
- 2) A **wrong** dream (A career is what you're paid for. A calling is what you're made for.)
- 3) A **stale** dream (God spoke to you years ago and it's died out.)
- 4) A **vague** dream (Write it down! This can bring clarity to your dream.)
- 5) A God-honoring, culture-defying, heaven-impacting, seemingly impossible **dream**.

**Surround yourself with people who will dream with you!**

## Discussion Questions

- Pastor Curt talked about the 5 people in the room. Which one do you feel best describes you currently?
- Have you ever found yourself chasing the wrong dream? Share how God opened your eyes to refocus on a God-honoring dream.
- Are you stuck in a stale or vague dream? As our pastor encouraged us, write it down.
- In the words of Pastor Curt, "What's your big, hairy, audacious dream?"

## Prayer Focus

Father, thank You for giving us the ability to dream. We pray for fresh, new, God-honoring dreams. Open our eyes, God, so we can make a difference. In Your name, Amen.

## Next Steps
