

### **Leader Conversation Guide – Advent: Love**

#### Main Idea

This week Pastor Curt continued in our Advent series, Christmas at Victory. He unpacked the second theme of Advent which is Love. Christmas brings us the source and an example of what love is all about and how to live it out. Read 1 John 4:7-19. As a believer, your life is founded in love and it's a love that comes from God. Why do we love? Because he first loved us. Christmas needs to be more than a day in the life of a believer, it needs to become a lifestyle. You can't live a life of love without knowing the source of love. We have to put Christmas in the right perspective.

## **Make it Practical**

Putting Christmas in the right perspective.

- The reason for the season is sin. Read Matt 1:18-21, Luke 2:8-12. After 400 years of silence the whole world is waiting for a Messiah, and in the first chapter of the New Testament, it comes to pass. This child will save his people from their sins. Sin is the reason for the season. But how often do we think about sin during Christmas? Nobody puts sin in their top 20 things I like about Christmas list.
- The motive for the season is love. Read John 3:16, Romans 5:8. The first mention of love in the Bible is found in Genesis 22 involving the love of a father for his son. The first mention of love in the New Testament is found in Matthew 3 as Jesus is being baptized and preparing to start his earthly ministry that would lead to his death and resurrection. God reserved love for those two places to express the depth of what true love is.

• The response to the season is completely up to us. It's up to you how you respond to God's provision for salvation through the gift of Christmas. If you've ever celebrated Christmas without an Easter, you haven't celebrated Christmas. You can't have a cross without a manager. This love was never meant to be about one day, it's Christmas everyday... that's why they call it the present!
