## Leader Conversation Guide – Tik-Tology: Part II

### Main Idea: Read Acts 7:20-29, Exodus 2:11-15.

This week Pastor Curt continued in our series Tik-Tology, pop culture's attempt to reshape theology. Theology is 'our thoughts about God'. PC has said it like this for three decades, "Show me your friends, and I'll show you your future." When God wants to bless your life He sends a relationship, and when the devil wants to disrupt your life, he sends a relationship. The problem though is when we are in *no relationships*, we are in danger. The flip side is If we are in *wrong relationships*, we can be devalued. When people don't recognize the gifts and purpose of God in their life, they will question everything they put their hands to. In the story of Moses in Exodus 2, Moses was listening to the wrong people! They made him question the call of God in his life (to set his people free) and ran. Then he began to question the power of God in his life. Unfortunately, the people closest to us often hurt us the most. In family relationships, we can get damaged. Pastor Curt encouraged us to evaluate our relationships, and look at 3 characteristics that Right Relationships have..

### Make it Practical: The Right Relationships are..

- **Gifted in areas you are not.** Read Acts 7:22, Ephesians 4:16. God loves bringing people into our lives to supplement the areas that we are weak. No one is good at everything. And that's okay. God has a plan and a purpose for your life. The two most important days in your life. #1. The day you were born. #2. The day you discover why.
- **Moving in the same direction.** Read 2 Timothy 2:22. Exodus 4:14. Before the Lord had the conversation with Moses at the burning bush, He had already spoke to Aaron and had a plan in motion. Even when we can't see it, He is at work!
- **Happy to be involved in your life.** Read Mark 3:13, Galatians 5:13-15. Life is too short to focus all of your attention on miserable people. The Bible says we are supposed to love everybody. But loving everybody, and hanging out with everybody are *two different things*. Mark 3:13 says Jesus "called to him those He wanted.." He intentionally chose who was around Him at certain times.

## Talk About It

- Based on Pastor Curt's characteristics of a Right Relationship, what are some of the 'Right Relationships' that God has placed in your life?
- Without naming names and specifics, what are some characteristics of wrong or unhealthy relationships God has helped navigate you through?
- What are some things you can do to build healthier relationships in your life?
