

Leader Conversation Guide – This is Him: Part I

Main Idea

This week, Pastor Curt started a new mini-series, titled "This is Him," focusing on the life and ministry of Jesus. From time to time we all lose our way. Whether it be in our marriage, at work, with your kids, finances, or some other relationship. You didn't mean to, but somewhere along the way you took a wrong turn. You feel like you've gone so far off track that you will never regain what you once had. In Mark 8:22-26, we read about a man who had lost his sight. We don't know how he ended up in this position, but he knew that Jesus could restore his vision. Christ offers us restored vision in our lives as well. Besides salvation, the greatest gift God can give you is clarity. We are never too far gone from Christ for Him to restore us to who He created us to be, and to see His plan for our lives.

"When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd."

Make it Practical

- Jesus takes us to His place. God has to get our attention to give us His direction. If you are not hearing the voice of God in your life, God has not stopped speaking. We have stopped listening. There are too many competing voices. It's just likes parenting kids, if you are going to give direction you must first get their attention.
- Jesus takes us through His process. God's kingdom is counterintuitive. If you want to find your life, you have to lose. If someone asks for your shirt, give them your coat. If someone asks you to walk a mile, walk two. Trust the process! Sometimes the process of where we are to where God wants us to be can be messy. And that is why so many leave or quit. Focus on the Master, not the miracle.
- Jesus wants to give us His perspective. If you have lost vision for your life, be encouraged, God has not! The key if we need to see it through His lens, Romans 12 tells us to "..let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think." Belief drives behavior. You have to stop believing the lies that have crept into your life. There is a world waiting for us to recapture our vision!
