Leader Conversation Guide – Vision Sunday

Main Idea

This week was Vision Sunday. Why Vision Sunday? Vision from God leads your life! Pastor Curt unpacked why we do what we do as a church, because when we lose our why we will lose our way. Our why, as a church, is founded in the same why as Jesus. Luke 19:10 – “I came to seek and save the lost.” That is our mission! To lead people into an everlasting relationship with Jesus. This is not a cruise ship where we lay around the pool, this is a battleship where we man our stations!

Make it Practical:
