Leader Conversation Guide - Back to the Basics (Part II):

Main Idea

This week, Pastor Steve continued our Back to the Basics series by reminding us about the power of words. God's character and the truth of His Word can come alive in our life in a powerful way. Through the power of our words in prayer, we are speaking life in to the circumstances around us. We are called to be vessels that shine the light of Christ into the dark world around us.

Make It Practical - Prayer and Fasting is:

1. An assumed practice

2. A means of seeking God

3. A focus on saying yes to God

We have the natural tendency to be overfilled with the things of the world. Fasting returns us to original intent... a vessel of honor.

2 Timothy 2:21 - "Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter (being unfit), he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work."
