



Leader Conversation Guide – XXVII - Romans (Part III):

Main Idea

This week Pastor Curt continued our XXVII series with a message from Romans chapter twelve about worship. “Worship” is defined as “to ascribe value, worth, or honor.” What are you worshipping with your life? Is it pulling you away from your relationship with God? How can we better live a lifestyle that ascribes value, worth, or honor to Him?

ROMANS 12:2A

Make It Practical: True Worship...

1. Is a response to God.
 - o We don't worship out of requirement. We worship as a response.
 - o 1 John 4:19 - “We love because He first loved us.”
 - o Our worship isn't dictated by how we feel, but by how good God is.
2. Is costly.
 - o Romans 12:1 - “offer your bodies as a living sacrifice”
 - o 2 Samuel 24:24 - But the king replied to Araunah, “No, I insist on paying you for it. I will not sacrifice to the Lord my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing.”
 - o We worship with our time, talent, and treasure.
3. Is a lifestyle.
 - o Worship isn't something we do, it's everything we do.
 - o Hebrews 13:15 - Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise - the fruit of lips that openly profess His name.
