Leader Conversation Guide – Replenish - Part 3

Main Idea

This week, evangelist Greg Hubbard shared a message from Luke 24:13-32, where we encounter two disciples walking on the road to Emmaus, reflecting on the recent events surrounding Jesus' crucifixion. Their hearts were heavy with confusion and disappointment. Yet, as they walked and talked, Jesus Himself drew near and walked with them, though they did not initially recognize Him.

This story is a powerful reminder of how Jesus meets us in our moments of uncertainty, revealing Himself through the Scriptures and His presence. As the disciples listened to Him and invited Him to stay, their hearts burned with a renewed passion and understanding. In this discussion, we will explore the significance of walking with God, listening to His voice, and desiring His presence. These themes challenge us to examine our own spiritual journey and deepen our relationship with Jesus. Let's open our hearts to what God wants to reveal to us through this powerful encounter on the road to Emmaus.

Talk About It

- Walking with God: Luke 24:15 mentions how the disciples walked with Jesus. Reflecting on Deuteronomy 10:12 and Genesis 5:24, what does it mean to “walk with God” in your daily life? How can we ensure our walk with Him is consistent and intimate?
- Listening to God’s Voice: According to Luke 24:27 and John 10:27, the disciples listened to Jesus as He explained the Scriptures. How do we cultivate the ability to hear God’s voice in our lives today? What challenges do you face in discerning His guidance?
- Desiring God’s Presence: In Luke 24:28-29, the disciples strongly desired to remain in Jesus’ presence. Reflecting on Matthew 5:6, how does a deep desire for God influence our spiritual growth? How can we foster a greater hunger for His presence in our lives?

Heavenly Father, thank You for our time together and for speaking to us through Your Word. As we leave this discussion, help us to walk closely with You, listen to Your voice, and seek Your presence in all we do. Fill our hearts with Your peace and guide us in the days ahead.
