## Leader Conversation Guide: My Church - Made for This

### Main Idea

Every person longs to live a life of meaning, but true fulfillment can only be found in walking the path God designed for us. Scripture reminds us that we are God’s handiwork—His masterpiece—created in Christ Jesus to do good works that He prepared in advance for us (Ephesians 2:10). That means your life is not an accident, and your purpose is not something you have to invent; it’s something you were born for.

This week’s message reminded us that we are saved by grace, not by works, but we are saved for a purpose. Grace is God’s power working in us to accomplish what we could never do on our own. When we see ourselves the way God sees us, we realize that every believer is called to ministry, every task matters, and every person is uniquely needed in the body of Christ. As we begin our discussion, let’s lean into this truth: God’s design in you reveals His destiny for you. May our eyes be opened to the hope of His calling, the richness of His inheritance, and the joy of making a difference in His kingdom.

### Make it Practical:

- You were created on purpose for a purpose. We are God’s handiwork—His masterpiece—created in Christ Jesus to do good works He prepared in advance for us (Ephesians 2:10). Grace saves us, not by our works, but we are saved for works.
- Every believer has a part to play in God’s plan. We are a chosen people and a royal priesthood (1 Peter 2:9). Every Christian is called to ministry, every task is important, and every person is uniquely needed in the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:27; Psalm 139:14).
- God’s design in you reveals His destiny for you. The Spirit gives each person gifts to show who God is and to benefit others (1 Corinthians 12:4-8). When we embrace how God made us, we discover our purpose and live with eternal impact.
