Leader Conversation Guide – For the 563K: Vision

Main Idea

God has never called His Church to stay comfortable or small-minded. From generation to generation, He has invited His people to expand their faith, trust His direction, and make room for more lives to be changed. Vision is not about building something impressive—it's about reaching people with the hope of Jesus and staying faithful to the mission He has given us.

This week's message challenged us to see beyond buildings and numbers and remember the heart behind the vision: people matter to God. As Victory Church looks ahead to the future, we are reminded that every person can play a part through prayer, serving, generosity, and personal responsibility. As we begin our discussion, let's ask God to stir our hearts for the people around us and help us live fully engaged in His purpose.

Make it Practical:

Stay focused on the mission.

- Vision helps keep the church moving in the right direction.
- The mission is helping people take the next step with Jesus.
- A growing church must stay centered on reaching people.
- Scriptures: Luke 19:10, Proverbs 29:18

2. Believe God for greater impact.

- God calls us to enlarge our faith and make room for more people.
- Vision requires faith, preparation, and obedience.
- We are called to think beyond where we are today.
- Scriptures: Isaiah 54:2-4, Proverbs 29:18

3. Personally engage in the mission.

- Every person has a role to play in reaching others.
- Prayer, serving, and generosity all advance God's Kingdom.
- We each help carry the vision forward.
- Scriptures: Matthew 9:37-38, Ephesians 2:10
