Leader Conversation Guide – Pass the Mic: Stewarding the Life God Gave You

Main Idea

Stewardship is about much more than finances—it is about recognizing that every part of our lives belongs to God. Because of His grace, we have been made alive in Christ, and everything we have, from our time and relationships to our gifts and resources, has been entrusted to us by Him.

This week, we were challenged to honestly ask ourselves whether we view our lives as our own or as God's. Faithful stewardship begins with surrender and grows as we intentionally honor God with every area of our lives. As we begin our discussion, let's ask God to reveal areas where He is calling us to greater faithfulness and trust.

Make it Practical:

Steward yourself well.

- Guard your heart, care for your body, and stay close to Jesus so you can faithfully live the life God has given you.
- Romans 12:1–2; Proverbs 4:23; Psalm 139:23–24

Steward the people and gifts God has entrusted to you.

- Honor your relationships, serve others with your gifts, and remember that people are entrusted to your care—not your control.
- Ephesians 5:21; Deuteronomy 6:4–9; 1 Peter 4:10

Steward your time and finances with trust.

- Choose faithfulness over busyness, practice rhythms of rest, and honor God first with your resources.
- Psalm 39:4–5; Proverbs 3:9–10; Matthew 6:21

Talk About It

How does remembering that “the earth is the Lord’s, and everything in it” change the way you view your daily life?

The message said, “Busyness is not faithfulness.” How have you experienced the difference between being busy and being spiritually fruitful?

If Jesus asked today, “What did you do with what I entrusted to you?” what answer would you hope to give?
