Leader Conversation Guide – Most Requested: Holy Spirit

Main Idea

The Holy Spirit is God's gift and His presence with us. Like the wind, we may not be able to see Him, but we can experience His power, His refreshing presence, and His work in our lives. He convicts us, guides us into truth, and walks with us as our Helper and friend.

Making room for the Holy Spirit begins with surrender. We have to move past fear and misconceptions and become open to everything God wants to do in us. The Holy Spirit is not simply a doctrine to understand—He is a Person to know and a presence to experience. This week, let's consider what it looks like to welcome Him more fully into our everyday lives.

The Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

JOHN 14:17

Make it Practical:

The Holy Spirit is unseen, but His presence is real. Like the wind, we cannot see Him, but we can recognize His work and experience His presence.

- John 14:17; John 3:8

The Holy Spirit brings power and refreshing. His presence gives us power to live for God and brings freedom as He transforms us to become more like Christ.

- Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 3:17-18

Make room for the Holy Spirit. Let go of fear and misconceptions, ask God for all He has for you, and become willing to follow His leading.

Talk About It

The Holy Spirit is described as our Helper, guide, and friend. Which of those descriptions stands out most to you, and why?

Can you think of a time when you sensed conviction or direction from the Holy Spirit? What did you do with it?

What might keep someone from fully making room for the Holy Spirit in their life? What would it look like to surrender that obstacle to God?

You may not be able to see the Holy Spirit, but you can experience His presence, power, guidance, and refreshing in your life.

Holy Spirit, thank You for being with us and in us. Help us let go of fear and misconceptions and become more open to everything You want to do in our lives. Give us the courage to follow Your leading, receive Your power, and allow You to transform us to become more like Jesus. Amen.

Next Steps

Spend time with the Holy Spirit. Begin each day this week by inviting His presence and asking Him to lead you.

Respond to conviction. When the Holy Spirit reveals something that needs to change, don't ignore it—confess it and take a practical step toward obedience.

Follow His direction. When you sense God prompting you to encourage, serve, forgive, pray, or step out in faith, respond rather than putting it off.
